
DIRECTIONS TO CAMP SCELKIT

From the NORTH: Maine Turnpike/I95 South. Go through toll barrier at York. Get off immediately after the toll booth, Exit 7 – York to U.S. Route 1. Turn left at stop sign. Bear right at the traffic light onto U.S. Route 1 South. Get in left lane; at the next light turn left onto Route 1A. Follow Route 1A for 1.3 miles through York Village. Turn right onto Lilac Lane (Route 103). Continue on Route 103 for 4.2 miles. Turn left onto Gerrish Island Lane (look for a large blue house on the right and a street sign for Fort Foster as you make the turn). Continue straight at the stop sign. Cross the bridge. Bear left at the fork in the road, Goodwin Road. Camp Scelkit is 1/2 mile on the left.

From the SOUTH: 195 North. Cross over the big green bridge (Piscataqua River Bridge) at Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Take Exit 2 Traffic Circle, Downtown. Follow the road under the overpass and around the traffic circle. Bear right just after the Dairy Queen Route 236 South, Kittery Point. After about a mile, Route 236 turns into Route 103 East (it's about 4 miles from the traffic circle to the left turn for camp). Turn right onto Gerrish Island Lane (there is also a sign for Brave Boat Harbor Road – look for a large blue house on the left side of Route 103 and a street sign for Fort Foster on the right side of the road as you make the turn). Continue straight at the stop sign. Cross the bridge. Bear left at the fork, Goodwin Road. Camp Scelkit is 1/2 mile on the left.
