Why do Girl Scouts celebrate?

Girl Scouts celebrate Global Action Week for Education so that all children, regardless of gender, income, or geography, have access to education.

How can GSME Girl Scouts celebrate?

As Service Units and Troops, celebrate Global Action Week for Education with discussion, activities, and community service. Whether at a Service Unit event or in your own troop, talk to girls about why education is important, especially to girls. A great way to open up this line of discussion is to use a toolkit from GSUSA; *Open the GATE:* <u>Girls' Access To Education Toolkit</u>. This toolkit has a game where girls explore the issues affecting girls' access to education.

Activities for Global Action Week for Education

The theme for Global Action Week for Education changes each year. These are suggestions for generic activities that can be modified based on any theme.

- Discuss with the girls how they can thank the individuals involved in their education each day of this week, and why this is important.
- Consider reading and discussing a book about schools and education in other countries, such as "Nasreen's Secret School: A True Story from Afghanistan" by Jeanette Winter. Although this book is suited for reading by Daisies and Brownies, it still leads to great discussion at all Girl Scout levels.
