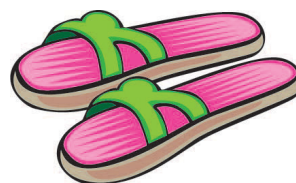

- Sustainability – we should explain what “triple bottom line” means and how sustainability reaches beyond recycling paper. We would talk about how sustainability affects planet, people and profit. (Our profit goes back into our programming to support people to get jobs) We would include a tour of our Recycling and Transportation Facility in Gorham, Maine if they either lived close enough.
- Disability awareness – in this segment, girls would discover how brain health is important. Goodwill has the largest neuro rehab center north of Boston (in Portland and Lewiston). A tour of the rehab center can be arranged if the girls live near Portland or Lewiston.
