What is GSME Amazing Race?

Ready. Set. Go! With other Girl Scout teams, take part in the ultimate travel-based scavenger hunt. Solve clues, visit the sites and complete challenges, all while learning important troop travel and budgeting skills.

- **GSME Amazing Race: Portland** – Girls will navigate Portland in a walking adventure through the city, start their journey with learning how to use public transportation. This Portland adventure is designed for Brownies and Juniors.
- **GSME Amazing Race: Boston** – Girls will explore Boston with a scavenger hunt through the city. They will start their journey with a train ride from Portland to Boston, while they plan their day based on clues. This Boston adventure is designed for Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors.

Who can participate?

- Teams of girls with adult leaders
- Individual girls with an adult
- Troop of girls with adult leaders

What skills do girls learn & practice during GSME's Amazing Race?

- Selecting what to do, planning, and budgeting for their day as a troop
- Experiencing diversity, new places, and different ways of life
- Reading a city map and planning the best route to get to their selected location(s)
- Learning about and experiencing public transportation
- Discovering how best to navigate a city, follow the flow of foot traffic, safely cross a city street, and travel as a group.
- Having fun and much more!

- To have a fun adventure as part of your troop's travel progression
- To allow girls to learn and practice both travel and budgeting skills
- To prepare girls for their next step in travel by having experiences with public transportation, city navigation, maps, etc.
