This starts with the simple field trip as a Daisy, such as a trip to the local Fire Department and progresses to day trips, simple overnights, two night trips, and finally regional, national or international trips as Seniors and Ambassadors. Girls make important decisions about where to go and what to do and take increasing responsibility for the planning of their trips, all while growing their organizational and management skills—skills that will benefit them throughout their lives.
