

Global Action Team Positions

- Purpose:** Global Action Team works with GSME Global Action Volunteer to create or advance programming and education in a variety of areas, with the goal of developing an increased awareness of global Girl Scouting and the interconnectedness of girls and girls' issues throughout the world.
- Term:** Council wide volunteer, appointed annually, with the option of reappointment based on demonstrated ability to fulfill the responsibilities of the position
- Accountable To:** Program Director; Highest Awards & Teen Experience Program Specialist; GSME Global Action Volunteer

Team Positions:

- **Global Action Volunteer**
 - Appointed by Girl Scouts of Maine
 - Heads the Global Action Team
 - Sets the team meeting schedule and agenda
 - Meets regularly with GSME Program Staff
 - Attends GSUSA Global Action meetings and trainings
- **Event Coordinator**
 - Organize and assist with planning global education events for GSUSA Global Action Days
 - Organize event(s) around girls completing global awards
 - Assist and act as resource for local level (Service Units, etc.) planning and execution of global events and programs.
 - Organize volunteer committees, comprised of both girls and adults, to execute global events
- **Travel Coordinator**
 - Knowledgeable on all global Girl Scout travel opportunities and resources
 - Prepare Girl Scouts for international travel
 - Coordinate Girls on the Go traveling nationally and internationally
 - Coordinate global travel promotions and speaking engagements
- **Promotion Coordinator**
 - Promote WAGGGS and Global Girl Scouting Opportunities.
 - Promote Global Action Team Events, Travel, Resources, etc.
 - Promote GSUSA and WAGGGS volunteer opportunities
 - Develop and maintain Global Action Team content calendar for promotion of Global Girl Scouting and Events
 - Prepare global content for use on GSME's social media, email blasts, publication, etc.
- **Global Action Team Specialists**
 - Assist with special projects/events.
 - This is an opportunity for recent Girl Scout Alumnae to stay involved and pop in to help with certain projects/events based on their school/work schedule.
