Girl Scouts of Maine Volunteer-in-Training Award Requirements

The Volunteer-in-Training (VIT) award is for Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors who would like to mentor a Daisy, Brownie, Junior or Cadette group outside of their camp or troop experience. If a girl has completed ninth grade, she is eligible to earn this award. A Volunteer-in-Training project needs to span a three-to-six month period. To earn the Volunteer-in-Training Award, a girl:

- 1. Finds an adult volunteer mentor who is currently the volunteer leader for a group of girls at the level she'd like to work with. This volunteer will help her through her training and internship, and the girl will help the volunteer with her group of girls for a three-to-six month period.
- 2. Completes the GSME Volunteer-in-Training Intent Form. Please email completed Intent Forms to highestwards@gsmaine.org
- 3. Completes the GSME Volunteer-in-Training Course which consists of:

a. Troop Volunteers, Part 1 - This is an online training. A link will be sent after she has

submitted her intent form.

b. Troop Volunteers, Part 2 – This training is offered in-person and on line throughout the Girl Scout year. A list of training dates can be found here: <u>https://www.girlscoutsofmaine.org/en/discover/activities/events.html</u>. A Girl Scout may only take this training after she has worked with a troop for at least 3 meetings.

- **4. Creates and implements a thoughtful journey project that lasts four or more troop sessions.** The Volunteer-in-Training is responsible for designing, planning, and evaluating activities. If a girl is passionate about a topic such as art or technology, she could design the activities around this topic. As a VIT, she might also help younger girls with a Take Action Project.
- 5. Completes and submits the Volunteer-in-Training Final Report and maintains a log of hours. Please email completed Final Reports and log of hours to <u>highestawards@gsmaine.org</u>.
